IMPRESSION TIPS

Common Error #1: Putty too warm.

Solution: Keep putty in refrigeration for at least 30 minutes before mixing. Then mix thoroughly for 90 seconds.




PLEAE NOTE: Warm putty hardens much quicker so make sure it's cold when you mix it. Mixing it when cold allows you to mix it for a full 90 seconds at a comfortable pace.

Common Error #2: Bite is too shallow and not centered.

Solution: Fill tray with putty to the front edge.

- Make sure to fill in the tray with putty to the front edge!
- With the putty in the tray you will need to press it firmly into your teeth to make a proper impression.



Practice Tips

- Practice putting the tray in your mouth and pressing it up (or down) onto your teeth.
- On your upper teeth, the tray might press into the roof of your mouth, which may be unpleasant.
- This is normal. When you put the putty in the tray it will feel better.
- In the tray, your teeth should not touch the edges.

Ready? It's easiest to do this with a friend to help you with the timing.



Let's Go!



- **1.** Putty must have been in **refrigeration** for at least 30 minutes prior to use.
- **2.** Have the impression tray ready.
- **3.** Put your gloves on.
- **4.** Open both putty containers.
- **5.** Take both putties out of containers.
- **6.** Have your friend start the timer!
- 7. Using only your fingertips, mix for a full 90 seconds. The putty should be one color when finished mixing.
- 8. Roll putty in your palms into a 4-inch log (10 seconds).

- **9.** Carefully press the log into the tray, making sure the putty goes up to the upper front edge of the tray (15 seconds).
- 10. Center your teeth over the putty, and press the tray **GENTLY** and **DEEPLY** making sure putty covers the gumline.
- **11.** Hold for 3 1/2 more minutes. Then gently remove without rocking the trav.




Remember to repeat these steps for each tray.

Inspect your Impressions:

- If your qumline is not clearly visible, then you didn't go deep enough. (See page 7 in your Impression Guide.)
- If you see your teeth have hit the plastic bottom, then you have gone a little too deep go a bit lighter on your 2nd try, but make sure the putty goes over the gumline.
- Don't worry about going too deep. Remember you have 2 chances.
